







Mediterranean Productive Garden: realizations in urban area

27-31 July 2019 Catania - Italy

Course organized by the Department of Agricultural, Food and Environmental Sciences, University of Catania in collaboration with Radicepura Foundation









Introduction & objectives of the course

Participants will learn theoretical and applicative aspects of gardens realization in urban area. The strengths and the possibilities linked to Mediterranean environments will be analyzed.

Target group and learning outcomes

The course is oriented toward degree students, professionals with interest in garden realization and ornamental plants.

After successful completion of this course students are expected to be able to:

Understand basic aspects of garden realization

Comprehension of strengths and weaknesses of Mediterranean climate Critically assess the ornamental plant utilization in urban environment Understand topics in plant arrangement for ornamental purposes

Assumed prior knowledge

Basic knowledge of ornamental plant characteristics and garden design.

Course fees

The course fee is € 150 for students and € 200 for professionals.

In order to help people in a financial problem proved with documentation students can apply for a grant offered by the Radicepura Foundation which will cover the fee for the Summer school – there are 2 grant available

Materials

The participants have to bring their own personal computer.

The course fee includes additional training material, welcoming dinner, coffee/tea, and informal reception.

Accomodation

Up to 20 off-site students will be able to count on accommodation at *Scuola Superiore di Catania* very close to the course location.; participants residing at a distance greater than 30 km can apply for it, for the assignment the criterion of the greater distance will be applied or will take precedence over others who come from a more distant place

Session Times

The course consists of theory and above all practical lessons and exercises.

In particular, the practical will include visit to areas where the gardens will be realized (1 or 2 based on the number of participants), analysis of strength and weakness aspects of the areas, plant choice, garden design



realization. At the end of each practical section, answers and reflections will be handed in.

Outline of the course in hours

The course will involve daily sessions, with a 2-hour theory session in the morning, and 4 hours in practical session in the morning and afternoon.

Articles and other accompanying materials will be distributed during the course.
